

Comparative Adjectives "Beep"

Language Focus

Comparative adjectives

Instructions

Copy and cut up one sheet for each group of 3 or 4 students.

Divide the class into groups and give each group a set of cards.

Explain that they are going to take turns to pick a card and make a sentence using the comparative form of the adjective. Instead of saying the comparative adjective out loud however, they will say "*beep!*" (for example "Elephants are *beep!* than mice."). The other students try to guess the adjective. They can make as many sentences as necessary until the adjective is guessed.

When groups begin to finish, get feedback and elicit a few example sentences from the game.
